

Shooter's Lab Use Policies

CODE OF CONDUCT:

All participants are expected to follow by Shooter's Lab code of conduct. We reserve the right to temporarily or permanently suspend any individual who is suspected of violating the code of conduct or facility use policies.

PRESUMPTION OF RISK:

All participants are willing to use Shooter's Lab under their own risk. Neither Pima County or staff assume liability for any injuries or accidents that may occur while in the facility.

INJURIES AND MEDICAL EMERGENCIES:

In the event that a serious injury may occur, 911 will be called. If the parent or guardian can't be reached Shooter's Lab reserves the right to seek emergency care for the minor with anything that may be deemed necessary regarding the injury. (Ex. Calling an ambulance)

Prohibited Activity and Substances:

No outside food or drinks. (Plastic water bottles and sports drinks are allowed, no glass.)

No alcohol, tobacco products, drugs or weapons are allowed.

No smoking in the building or premises.

No type of harrasment, intimidation or using of words or gestures that may be obscene.

CONSENTS:

All guests shall sign waivers and consent to having their images photographed or filmed and used by Shooter's Lab for promotion purposes.

USER RESPONSABILTIES:

Coaches or any event or program coordinators are responsible for the supervision and control of guests that are participating at Shooter's Lab. Children under the age of 16 years old may not be left unsupervised. PLEASE REPORT ANY CONCERNS.
